This exhibition may tour for 2-3 years. **Artists are responsible for the sale/delivery of the sold piece. The artist must contact the purchaser, complete the transaction and deliver to purchaser.**

Packaging Instructions for Sask Terra Exhibitions

<u>Please Read Carefully (there have been some changes)</u> These instructions apply to submissions for all Sask Terra shows. Improperly packed entries will not be accepted for jurying.

- 1. Each submission is to be packed in a separate container.
- 2. Completed artist agreement/entry form is to be attached to the outside of each container.
- 3. Name, address and telephone number of the entrant should be prominently displayed on the outside of the container along with a picture to indicate the piece in the container.
- 4. Detailed packing and unpacking instructions should be firmly attached to the inside lid of the container. A simple sketch or photos accompanying the instructions would be useful. Include any specific display instructions. Indicate with arrows on the container which way up.
- 5. **Do not use cardboard boxes!** We recommend the following: a hard plastic square or rectangle lidded container of a suitable size (recommended 2 to 3 inches larger than your piece), preferably with clip closures and no protruding handles. Over-sized containers are difficult to transport and take up extra space often causing extra trips.
- 6. Use duct tape to secure the lid in place if necessary being careful not to cover any paper attached.
- 7. Line the container with soft foam or 1" Styrofoam on all sides, top and bottom. Scrap foam is available from upholsterers.
- 8. Delicate protrusions should be protected with cardboard, etc. Wrap the object in soft plastic, such as dry cleaners' plastic to protect surface from abrasion and soiling. A recommendation is to wrap your piece with 3 or 4 layers of bubble wrap (bubbles facing toward the piece) then settle the object into the foam/Styrofoam lined container. Surround the object with soft foam, bubble pack, styrofoam peanuts (fill several small plastic bags and place around the piece) (no shredded paper or newsprint). Be sure the object cannot shift in its container and that the lid does not compress the piece. Please no crushed newsprint.
- 9. With sets, wrap each piece separately in appropriate material. Ensure that the pieces are well protected from crushing or banging each other in the container.
- 10. A photograph of the piece must be displayed on the outside of the container. This aids in finding the proper container for your pieces.
- 11. Your entry fees and signed Artist Agreement must be attached to outside of the container.
